Dear FLHS Student and Parent,

You are receiving this letter because you have or you are a student currently enrolled in at least one Advanced Placement (AP) course. In this letter I will outline important information about the AP exam registration and payment process.

General AP Exam Information

Students enrolled in AP courses are expected to take the AP exam as a prerequisite of the course. Scoring well on an AP exam can often earn students' college credit for their high school class, saving a significant amount of money on tuition. To check the specific policy of most colleges and universities regarding AP scores, please visit the <u>AP Credit Policy Search</u>.

Registration & Payment

The registration and payment process for AP exams begins in the Fall. There is a **two-step process** to register and pay for AP exams:

- 1. Join your AP class(es) on the <u>College Board website</u>, using your class specific join code. Class codes are listed on pages 2-3 of this letter.
- 2. Pay for your AP exams on <u>Total Registration</u>.

IMPORTANT: Steps 1 and 2 MUST be completed in order to have your AP exam(s) ordered.

Fees

Each AP exam costs \$105 and payment is due by October 31, 2019. All exams ordered after October 31 will incur a late fee. See below for important dates.

Registration & Payment Timeline

- **Tuesday, October 1, 2019** at 8:00 AM Registration Begins
- **Thursday, October 31, 2019** at 11:00 PM Registrations and payments after this date and time will incur a \$25 late fee per exam.
- **Thursday, November 14, 2019** at 11:00 PM Registrations and payments after this date and time will incur a \$65 late fee per exam.
- Thursday, November 14, 2019 Date by which students may cancel an exam and receive a full refund.
- Thursday, February 27, 2020 Date by which students may cancel an exam and incur a \$40 cancellation fee per exam.
- Friday, February 28, 2020 Cancelations after this date will *not receive a refund*.
