Dear Grade 10 Parent or Guardian,

Fairfield Ludlowe High School will be administering the PSAT/NMSQT to grade 10 students on **Tuesday, January 26**. There is no cost for students to take the PSAT/NMSQT and they will be automatically registered for the test. Students are encouraged to review the [PSAT/NMSQT Student Guide](#) to help prepare for the test. Hardcopies of the PSAT/NMSQT Guide are available outside of room 266.

Students are encouraged to review this material and use the practice full length test to help them understand the types of questions they will be asked. It is important to understand that this test is purely a practice and diagnostic tool; PSAT scores are not sent to colleges.

ARRIVAL/DISMISSAL/SNACKS

Students should arrive to FLHS no later than 7:30 am. Transportation will be provided for students who take a bus. Students should arrive with a mask that they will have to wear for the duration of the test. In addition, students must arrive to the testing session with **two #2 pencils and a calculator**.

All standard timed testers will be dismissed at approximately 11:30 am. Students who receive extended time College Board SSD accommodations will be dismissed at approximately 1:00 pm. Buses will be provided for both dismissal times.

Students are encouraged to bring a snack to eat during their scheduled break.

TESTING LOCATIONS

Students will be assigned to a testing room based on their cohort assignment and last name. There will be no more than 11 students assigned per testing room. We will be maintaining social distancing guidelines in all locations.


TESTING SCHEDULE
