Dear FLHS Student and Parent,

The College Board's Advanced Placement (AP) Program recently published expanded windows of time for the administration of AP Exams this spring. High Schools across the country and around the world must determine the most safe, effective and fair way to administer AP Exams to their students.

Fairfield Public School district and high schools administrative teams spent considerable time discussing when to administer AP Exams in Fairfield. In order to make this important decision, we took into account College Board's national test exam administration dates (which cannot be changed), test options (i.e. administered at-home and/or digitally), space availability, students exposure to complete course content and skills, and providing enough time between tests to support the social-emotional wellbeing of our students.

Based on the aforementioned information, Fairfield Ludlowe High School will be offering AP Exams during the following dates, times, and testing platforms:

- Any student who wishes to cancel their exam must log into <u>Total Registration</u> and "request exam cancellation". A full refund will be processed.
- As exams come closer, more instructions will be provided.
