Dear Grade 10 Parent or Guardian,

Fairfield Ludlowe High School will be administering the PSAT/NMSQT to grade 10 students on **Wednesday**, **October 16.** There is no cost for students to take the PSAT/NMSQT and they will be automatically registered for the test. All students will receive the <u>PSAT/NMSQT Student Guide</u> in homeroom. Students are encouraged to review this material and use the practice full length test to help them understand the types of questions they will be asked. It is important to understand that this test is purely a practice and diagnostic tool; PSAT scores are not sent to colleges.

On October 16, all grade 10 students will test with their **homeroom at 7:30 a.m.** Students must come school with **two #2 pencils, a graphing calculator and a picture ID.** Students will be dismissed from school at 11:45 a.m. No lunch will be served.

Test results can be accessed by mid-December via the student's College Board account. Students will receive an email when their PSAT scores are available. Students should visit <u>College Board's website</u> to create an account, if needed. When creating an account, use the student's active personal email account, not their school email.
